we believe God has called us to be a welcoming, outward-reaching and diverse all-age community living and growing<sup>5</sup> for the glory of God by making, nurturing, equipping and sending disciples of Jesus Christ<sup>6</sup> who are continually being filled<sup>7</sup>, transformed<sup>8</sup>, led<sup>9</sup> and empowered<sup>10</sup> by God's Spirit to actively share in God's mission of love to the world as ambassadors of Christ.<sup>11</sup>
